How to read the Subject Percentile Table (SPT) for each subject

1. Refer to your child's Result Slip (Part A) and note his/her marks for each subject.
2. Match each mark to the range of marks reflected in the Subject Percentile Table (Part B) for each subject.

1. Marks obtained for **English** is 82.0 as shown in the results slip.

Part B: Subject Percentile Table (SPT) for English

English	
Mark Range	Percentile (%) Range
≤ 62.3	≤ 25
62.4 – 69.5	26 – 50
69.6 – 78.8	51 – 75
≥ 78.9	≥ 76

2. Match the marks to the mark range in the **English** SPT.

3. For the mark range of ≥ 78.9 , the corresponding percentile range is ≥ 76 .

In the above example, the child's mark obtained for English is 82.0. The corresponding percentile range would be ≥ 76 .

A subject percentile range of ≥ 76 means this child's score is equal to or better than that of 76% of the cohort for the subject.
